State Contribution

Source of Match: Internal agency loan which is repaid with interest payments from SRF loans

Leveraging Profile

Frequency: Frequently (every year)

First Year: Clean Water SRF: 1989 and Drinking Water SRF: 1997

Bond Rating: AAA

Technical Assistance ("set asides" for small systems and local and state programs)

Drinking Water: 27%

Interest Rates

Basis: Tiered interest rates based on market rates and applicant need

Clean & Drinking: .5% - 2.25% for loans up to \$3 million

70% - 80% of market rate for loans over \$3 million which are typically paired

with a municipal bond

Additional Subsidization (percent of capitalization grant used for principal forgiveness/grants)

Clean Water: 10% or \$1.5 million whichever is less

Drinking Water: 20%

Type: Principal Forgiveness
