



Clean Water and Drinking Water State Revolving Funds Additional Subsidization

The Clean Water and Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (SRF) provides subsidized loans and additional subsidization for water infrastructure that protects public health and the environment. Subsidized loans are loans at or below market rate. Additional subsidization is financial assistance that doesn't need to be repaid, including Principal Forgiveness, grants, and negative interest rates.

In 2020, federal law requires 10% of the federal capitalization grant for the Clean Water SRF and 20% of the federal capitalization grant for the Drinking Water SRF to be used for additional subsidization for any eligible applicant. In addition, federal law also allows each SRF to use up to 30% of the federal capitalization grant for applicants that meet affordability criteria.
